<p>Overview Novice Transfer Students have basic to little knowledge about the transfer process. Most of the information they have received is informally through second hand resources: friends, TV, word-of-mouth. They most likely do not have a set transfer plan, and are unaware of the requirements to apply for a four year college and their department major.</p>	<p>Overview Scout Transfer Students have basic knowledge of transferring. They may have visited a college website, spoken with an advisor about their interest in transferring, but have not developed a concrete plan, or have not gathered essential information to prepare for transferring: pre-requisites, requirements, deadlines.</p>	<p>Overview Scholar Transfer Students are well prepared for the transfer process. They have a clear graduation and transfer timeline. They have met on numerous occasions with advisors at Highline, their prospective university, and their department. All transfer application materials are on their final stages if not complete (resume, personal statement, letters of recommendation).</p>
